
TORNEO INTERNAZIONALE DI NATALE Città di Lugano Lido di Lugano – 17 e 18 dicembre 2022

The Christmas Tournament City of Lugano is reserved exclusively for the U13 category (athletes born from 2010 onwards).

General and organizational directives

Teams can be composed of boys and girls, without any distinction or limitation on the number, but with a minimum of 8 players and a maximum of 13 per report and 7 players in the water (6 movement + 1 goalkeeper). Managers must submit to the organization, not later than the beginning of the Tournament, through the file made available with this document, the list of players and fill in the reports for the individual games made available by the organization.

Athletes must bring with them an identity document and the organization has the right to any checks in order to protect the proper conduct of the event. In case of irregularities, the player involved will be immediately disqualified from the tournament.

At the same time, the organization undertakes not to disclose the data of individual athletes to third parties.

For those who will participate with two teams, the transfer of an athlete from one team to another after the start of the competition not be allowed.

The matches will be played on 25-meter fields, in two halves of 7 minutes continued, with an interval of 2 minutes per time, without 30 ", with the clock that will be stopped in case of goal, ball out or any injuries or refereeing needs.

The two finals will be played in two halves of 8 minutes continued.

Formula

The first phase of the event will see the teams divided into three groups (two of 4 and one of 5) compete against each other in one-way matches. At the end of the first stage, teams classified at first place will be admitted to the second round and will compose group A, seconds group B, thirds group C and fourths plus the only fifth group D.

With the composition of the aforementioned groups, the second phase will begin, which will allow the definition of the starting grid of the quarter-finals.

The three teams from Group A will qualify directly to the quarter-finals, along with the top two teams from Group B and the first from Group C. The remaining teams will form knockout matches to enter the final draw. (check calendar).

The first three final classified will be awarded.

Special prizes will be awarded, following an evaluation by a technical commission, to the best goalkeeper, the best player and the top scorer of the event.

Rules

The current FINA rules, except for the new 2-meter rule, will apply to all matches.

Specifically, the shot from 6 meters will be available, direct or after single throw in as per regulation.

In the group stages, for each game won, 3 points will be awarded in case of a win, 1 in case of a draw and 0 in case of defeat.

In case of equal score in the standings between two teams, the following values will be considered, in order:

- a) Result in the match between the teams with equal points
- b) Goal difference between teams with the same points
- c) Most goals scored among teams with the same points
- d) Goal difference in the group
- e) Most goals scored in the group

In case of equal score in the standings between more than two teams, the following values, typical of the detached ranking, will be considered:

- a) Points scored in head-to-head confrontations
- b) Difference between goals scored and conceded in head-to-head matches
- c) Overall goal difference in the league
- d) Number of goals scored in general in the league

In the knockout stage, a draw will not be allowed. In case of a tie at the end of regular time, each team will designate 5 penalty takers for the classic series of penalties. If even at the end of this stage the teams are still tied, each team will alternately make a penalty shot until the victory is awarded.

Referees and secretaries, disciplinary provisions

A referee will regulate the course of the match, while a secretary will take care of the protocol of the same, the control of the score and any irregular entries, as well as the count of fouls and goals.

Temporary exclusions will be maximum 3 per player and lasting 20". After the third temporary expulsion, re-entry into the water will not be allowed.

The player who disrespects opponents or referees, and therefore suffers a definitive exclusion for unsportsmanlike behavior, can be immediately replaced, but will be automatically disqualified for the next game.

Only the coach and a maximum of two designated persons per team will be allowed to be present on the bench, any players not called up will have to sit in the stands.

Only the coach will be able to give instructions to the team and walk along the edge of the pool to the line of his 5 meters of defense in case of attack of his team and inside his 2 meters of defense in case of defense of his team, without hindering the movements of the referee.

Technicians and club officers are required to wear the same clothing, to make them easily recognizable.

A coach or club officer excluded for protests will not be allowed to sit on the bench for the remainder of the game in which the exclusion takes place and for the following game.

In case of disturbance to the conduct of the game created by coaches or supporters in the stands, which will make it difficult for the game to run smoothly, the referee may suspend the game temporarily.

In case of continuation of this disturbance, the match will be considered over and a 5-0 defeat will be awarded to the team whose supporters or coach or club officer on the bench will have been considered responsible for the incident. In the event that the disturbance involves either teams or the public of both teams, the match will have no winner and the 5 - 0 defeat will be awarded to both.

People named in the form received are responsible for their athletes and with the acceptance of the regulation, Lugano Aquatics is declined of any responsibility in case of accidents or injuries during the two days of the tournament.

HOW TO REACH THE POOL

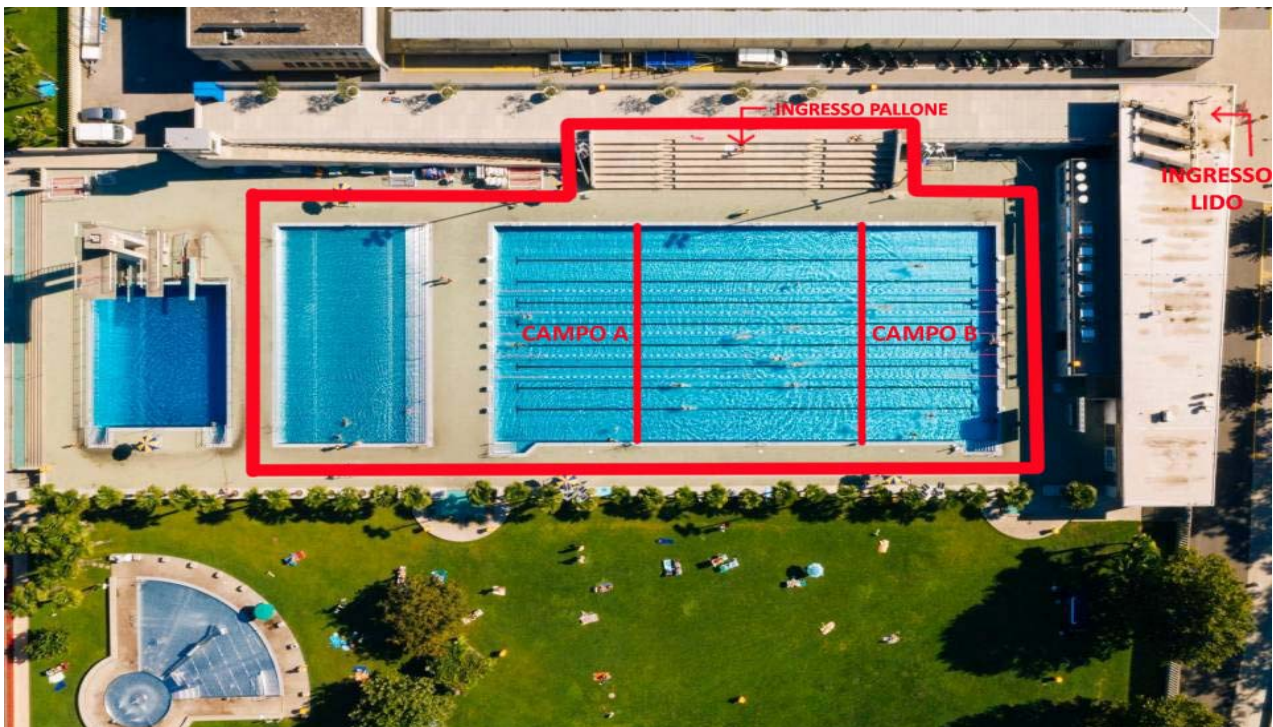
The entrance to our fantastic structure will be from Via Foce, Lugano.

The 50-meter pool will be divided into three sections: two playing fields (CAMPO A and CAMPO B) and a central area that can be used as a warm-up only and exclusively by the teams involved in the matches immediately following the games in progress, without the use of balls and without hindering the games in progress.

The 25-metre swimming pool can also be used for this purpose.

The whole structure, including the stands, will be protected by the balloon (the red external delimitation in the image below).

It is forbidden to eat meals inside the facility, Lugano Aquatics will equip the balcony area (near the entrance) with tables and a well-stocked snack area, with drinks, sandwiches and much more, both for athletes and for all supporters.
