## GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>ACCREDITATIONS:</u> On the first day of training, the members of each team will receive their accreditations cards from the accreditation room after their identification.

<u>OPENING CEREMONY:</u> The opening ceremony will be at the competition pool on Wednesday, June 23, at 14:00. One athlete per country must be ready at the protocol area at 13:00 (details TBC at the technical meeting on June 22).

TRAINING – WARM UP SESSION: Schedule for training will be arranged based on number of events entered, after considering the number of federations, date and time of arrivals and will be announced soon.

<u>CHANGING ROOMS:</u> Each country has to use their own changing rooms. There will be names on each door.

#### **COMPETITION CONDUCTION:**

Individual diving events on 1m & 3m Springboard and Platform will be held in two sessions with Preliminaries and Finals. Top twelve (12) divers from preliminaries will proceed in a final competition performing only dives without difficulty degree limit. The starting order in the Final will be in reverse order to the divers' placing at the end of the Preliminaries determined by total scores received. The scores of the dives with limit from the preliminary session will be carried forward and added to the scores in the final competition to determine the top twelve (12) rankings. Divers lower than twelfth place will be ranked by their preliminary scores. The Mixed Team Event is an event where up to 4 divers compose the team (both genders including minimum one group B diver) and must complete 6 dives without difficulty degree limit all from different groups in 4 rounds. Event includes 2 individual dives performed one by one by each gender from the springboard 3m and 2 individual dives – one by one by each gender from the Platforms 5m, 7,5m or 10m. 2 mixed synchronised dives: one should be performed from 3m springboard and one from 5, 7.5 or 10 meter platform height. One (1) team per Nation is allowed in this direct final.

<u>VICTORY CEREMONIES:</u> The victory ceremonies will be held right after finals. The presentation of medals, the national anthem of the gold medalist will be played, and the national flags of medalists will be shown at the scoreboard. Athletes are reminded to attend all victory ceremonies in their official National Federation tracksuit with appropriate footwear.

Medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places in all events.

<u>FINAL SPORT ENTRIES:</u> European Aquatics will send to the respective Federations the link to enter European Aquatics EMS System for Final Sport Entries and Accreditations.

<u>PARTICIPANTS:</u> All European Aquatics Federations are eligible to participate in the European Aquatics Junior Diving Championships. Maximum 2 entries per Federation per event is allowed for individual events. Maximum 1 entry per Federation per event is allowed for Synchro and Mixed Team Events (1 Team per Nation).
